Senior researcher; within the research structure "Law and Economics", his primary activity centers on the following theme: theoretical analysis of the contributions of institutional economics, with the main aim of evaluating, through the collection and study of relevant data, the norms, policies, and institutions best able to attain the goals of economic and social development.

Within this ambit, he is analysing the following interrelated issues: (i) theoretical advances of institutional economics, with a particular focus on the interaction with other fields of social and psychological sciences; (ii) the structural problems of the Italian economy, with special attention to development strategies for the most disadvantaged regions and to the topic of sustainable development; (iii) the regulation of public utilities within the new legislative and institutional framework; (iv) the reform process of the public administration and the role played by the European Union, with special attention to the problem of coordination among policies and institutions.

From May 1999 to April 2006 he represented ISAE, acting as a deputy member of CIPE-NARS (Consulting Committee for the Enactment of Guidelines for the Regulation of Public Utilities), where, among other institutional activities, he took part in the postal sector Working Group.
